ENTRIES: The entry fee will be \$10.00 per individual up to maximum of \$150.00 per team, if **paid by March** 19th (\$175/\$20 if paid after March 19th). Team fee will include lunch for Coaches. Please make

checks payable to Jesuit Athletics.

Entries must be submitted online at www.directathletics.com Contestants are limited to 3 running events and 5 total events. Individual events are open to all-comers interested in competing with the best State, National and Area ranked athletes. Relay events (4x100, 4x200 & 4x400) are by invitation only.

Maximum of two (2) entries are permitted in the following events; 100m, 200m, 400m, 100/300m hurdles. Preliminary heats will be run as needed. The 800m, 1600m, 3200m, and Relay events are one-heat finals only with no preliminary heats.

Up to <u>three (3) entries</u> are permitted in the 800m, 1600m, 3200m and field events subject to lane availability. The 800m will be limited to twelve contestants, the 1600m is limited to 18 contestants and up to 24 contestants will be accepted in the 3200m and field events.

Changes can be made through Wednesday, 3/9/16 with the **final start list** published on JSRelays.org the following day, Thursday, March 10th

Contestants will be seeded according to times submitted and cross referenced to previous published times on the <u>Area Leaders List</u> and other State and National rankings to ensure the best possible competition in all races.

AWARDS: Medals for first, second and third place finishers in all events and Trophies for relay winners, High Point winner and 1st place team. All awards will be available at End of Meet in the "West" Press Box.

<u>RULES</u>: The meet will be governed by the National Federation of High School Associations rules.

High Jump starting height will be 4'8" and will rise in 2" increments to 5'4". Above 5'4" the bar will be raised in 1" increments.

Long and Triple Jump contestants will be allowed 3 jumps in the preliminary round. Eight finalists will be allowed 3 additional jumps in the final round.

Pole Vault starting height will be 10' and will rise in 6" increments.

Shot Put and Discus contestants will be allowed 3 throws in the preliminary round. Eight finalists will be allowed 3 additional throws in the final round. Implements will be pooled.

Curve judges will be present for all races. Please make sure that your athletes understand the rules prior to racing.

Official timing will be fully automatic as times and places will be determined from the Finish Lynx System. The meet director will make all logistic decisions regarding placement of starting and finish lines, runway direction, and timing systems.

Audible tape decks and radios will not be permitted in the stands, warm-up or competition areas.

COACHES There will be a Coaches meeting at 7:30, please have at least one coach there to represent your school.

TEAM Team camps can be set up in the Home (West side) Stands, no Tents are allowed on turfed areas or in the Stands.

WARM-UP Warm up will be on the Lower field, **NO Athletes or Coaches** will be on the infield. The track will be open from 7:00 until 9:00 and 1:00 until 1:50 for Relays teams to work on exchanges and marks.

HEATING The heating clerk & benches will be outside the Southeast corner of the track near the baseball stadium, the group will be walked to the starting line.

RELAY All members of relays teams must be checked in and will be walked to their exchange Zones. TEAMS:

<u>MEALS</u>: A meal will be provided for coaches following completion of the morning preliminaries. Also, we will have a concession stand selling barbecue other types of nourishing "all day food".

HEAT Will be available online at http://jsrelays.org/2016.htm. Printed copies will be available Saturday morning on the Plaza at the Northwest corner of the track after conclusion of the scratch meeting.

The Finals Version will be available online or on the Plaza at the Northwest corner of the track after 1:30 pm.
